

6.	In preparation for the Passover meal, a household was to select a lamb . On what day of what month were they to select it?
	On what day were they to kill the lamb?
	What side dishes were they to eat along with the lamb?
	How quickly were they to eat the meal (v. 11)?
7.	What were they to do with some of the lamb's blood (v. 7)?
	How were they to apply the blood to the lintel and doorposts (v. 22)?
	What was the purpose of the blood?
8.	After the people were given instructions re. the Passover, what was their response in vv. 27, 28?

9.	Verses 14-20 describe the Feast of Unleavened Bread , which came after the Passover meal. How many days did this feast last?
	What were they to do on the first and seventh days of this feast (v. 16)? What were they not to do on those days?
	If anyone ate anything leavened during this feast, what would happen to them?
	How many years were they to celebrate this feast (vv. 14, 17)?
