2. Read about the Feast of **Unleavened** Bread in 13:3-10. It was to be celebrated in the first month. What was the name of this month?

How long did the feast last?

Leavened bread was not to be seen in what places (13:7)?

3. All the **firstborn** in Israel were to be sacrificed to the Lord, but there were a couple of exceptions to this rule. What/who were to be **redeemed** and not sacrificed (13:13, 16b)?
4. Read 13:14-15. In your own words, what would you say was the purpose of the Israelites giving their **firstborn** to God?

5. The instructions about the Feast of Unleavened Bread (13:3-10) and the instructions about the firstborn (13:11-16) have a lot of **similarities**. Fill in each of the blank boxes below with the verse(s) that correspond to the statements on the left. A couple have been done for you.

16. In verses 13 and 17, what several different ways does Moses describe the place that God was bringing His people to?

17. What's the main theme of verses 14-16?

18. From verses 20-21, write down several things that you can learn about **Miriam**.
