3.	In 15:5, the enemy sank like a what? In verse 10, they sank like what?
4.	In 15:13, how are God's people described? In verse 16, how are they described?
5.	15:14-16 describes how the surrounding nations would react to what God did at the Red Sea. Write down four or five different words or phrases that describe the fear that the nations felt.
6.	When Israel couldn't drink the bitter water at Marah, what did they do (v. 24)?
	As you read through chapters 15-17, on how many occasions do you see Israel complaining/grumbling?

7.	15:25 says that God tested Israel. What was the test?
	What else did God say He would use to test them (see 16:4)?
8.	When the people were hungry, they complained against Moses and Aaron, but who did Moses say they were complaining against (16:7, 8)?
9.	How is manna described in 16:14? How is it described in verse 31?
10.	God gave Israel certain laws about collecting manna. In what different ways did they disobey (see 16:19-20 and 16:25-28)?
11.	From 16:22-30 (especially vv. 23, 29, 30), write down three things that you can learn about the Sabbath .
12.	What did Aaron do with an omer of manna?
13.	At Rephidim, not only did the people complain against Moses, but what else did they do to him (17:2)?
14.	In 17:1-7, what three statements or questions do the people make?

15.	In I Corinthians 10:4, Paul says that Israel "drank from the spiritual Rock that followed them, and that Rock was Christ." In what way(s) do you see that this rock that Moses struck was like Christ?
16.	When Moses left the people and went to the rock at Horeb, who and what was he to take with him (17:5)?
	In addition to the elders, who else was with him there (17:6)?
17.	When Israel was attacked by the Amalekites , Moses' battle plan was two-fold. What was Joshua to do (17:9a)? What would Moses do (17:9b)?
18.	What did Moses write and what did Moses build to indicate that the Lord would make war with the Amalekites?
