1. In chapter 24, how many times did the people say that they'd **obey** or do all the words that the Lord had spoken?
2. Where did Moses sprinkle half of the **blood** from the sacrifices? Where did he sprinkle the other half of the blood?
3. T or F Moses and the leaders of Israel saw God.
4. Why did God call Moses to come up on the mountain (24:12)?

When he went up to the Lord on the mountain, how long was he up there?

5. Which individuals were to make a **contribution** to the Lord (25:2)?

6. What was the purpose of the tabernacle (25:8)?

7. God gave instructions about making an **ark** (25:10ff). What instructions about the poles for the ark were given (v. 15)?

What was to go inside the ark?

What was to go on top of the ark?

What would the Lord do above the Mercy Seat and between the cherubim (v. 22)?

8. God gave instructions about building a **table for bread** in 25:23-30. Read more about this table for bread in Leviticus 24:5-9 and answer the following questions:

How many loaves of bread went on the table?

How often were Aaron and his sons to arrange the bread and eat it?

9. How many branches did the **lampstand** have?

How many lamps did it have?

Each branch had bowls or cups that were shaped to look like an almond blossom. How many bowls/cups were on each branch? How many were on the lampstand itself?

10. The tabernacle was covered with ten **curtains** made out of what (26:1-7)?

There were eleven curtains made out of what (vv. 8-13)?

There were also **coverings** made out of what two materials (v. 14)?

11. The tabernacle had 10 cubit (15 foot) upright **boards** or **frames** to support it.
How many were in the entire tabernacle (25:15-25)?

12. What piece(s) of furniture went in the Most Holy Place? In the Holy Place?

13. Up until chapter 27, the pieces of furniture had been overlaid with gold. What was the **altar** overlaid with?

14. What was the length, width, and height of the **courtyard** of the tabernacle?

The courtyard had **pillars** of bronze around its borders.
How many pillars went around the courtyard?
