Please read Exodus 27 and answer the following questions...

1. A cubit is 18 inches. In feet and inches, what was the length, width, and height of the **altar** of burnt offering?

The altar was not overlaid with gold, but with what?

What was on the four corners of the altar (v. 2)? What was midway up the altar (vv. 4-5)?

2. What was the length, width, and height of the **courtyard**?

The boundaries of the courtyard were 60 pillars. What was affixed to them, so that the people of Israel couldn't see inside the courtyard (vv. 9, 11, 14, 18)?

3. In the tabernacle was a **lamp**. When were Aaron and his sons to tend the lamp?

Please read Exodus 28 and answer the following questions...

4. What three terms are used to describe Aaron's priestly garments in verse 2?

5. The **ephod** was a long, sleeveless vest. On which part of the ephod were two stones put?

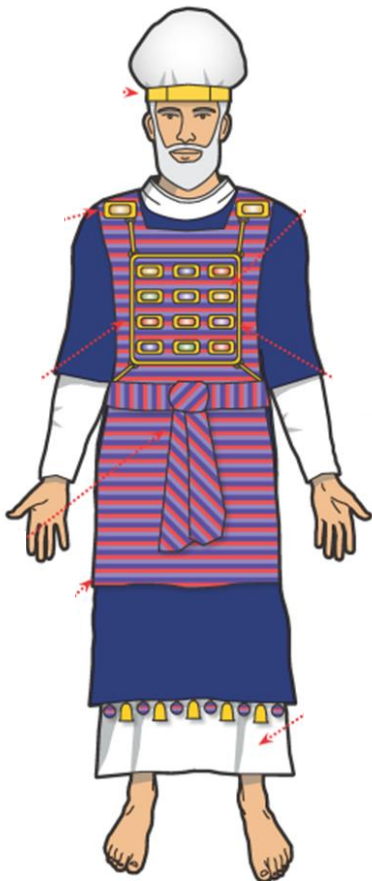
What was engraved on each of the two stones?

6. A **breastpiece** was attached to the ephod. Verses 15, 29, & 30 call it a breastpiece of _____.

What was the size of the ephod?

On the ephod were four rows of stones. What was engraved on each stone?

The breastpiece had the Urim and Thummim inside it. Read Numbers 27:21, I Sam. 30:7-8, and Ezra 2:63. What would you say was the purpose of the Urim and Thummim?



7. What two things went on the hem of the blue **robe**?

8. What went on the front of the **turban** the high priest wore?

9. **Aaron's sons** dressed in what four things (vv. 40, 42)?

10. Aaron bore the names of the **12 tribes** in what two places?

Please read Exodus 29 and answer the following questions...

11. Moses brought a basket of bread and what three animals to the tabernacle (vv. 1-3)?

12. Describe the steps Moses went through to **consecrate** Aaron as the high priest (vv. 4-9).

13. The bull Moses brought was killed. Part was burned on the altar. Where was the rest burned?

The first ram Moses brought was killed. How much of it was burned on the altar?

The second ram Moses brought was killed. Part of its blood was put on the altar, but part of its blood was applied where else (vv. 19-21)?

Part of the second ram was burned up as a sacrifice to God, but what was done with the remainder of the ram (vv. 26-34)?

14. Once the priests were consecrated, what were they to offer **every day** to the Lord?

15. From verses 42-46, what would you say was the main **purpose** of the tabernacle?

Please read Exodus 30-31:11 and answer the following questions...

16. In chapter 30, God tells Moses to build two more items – one to go inside the tabernacle and one to go out in the courtyard. What two items was he told to build?

17. The Lord told Moses to take a **census**. If the people didn't take part in it, what punishment would they suffer?

How much did each have to give as a census tax?

Once the census tax was gathered, what was it used for?

18. In verses 22-38, **spices** were to be blended and made into what two different things to use in tabernacle service?

19. What were some of the **gifts** and **skills** that Bezalel and Oholiab were given in order to design and construct the tabernacle?
