

# EXODUS 4.24-6.30

1. Go back and skim over chapter 1. In 15 words or less, what was chapter 1 about?

Go back and skim over chapter 2. In 15 words or less, what was chapter 2 about?

Go back and skim over 3:1-4:17. In 15 words or less, what was that section about?

2. What shocking thing did the Lord try to do to Moses as he and his family were on the way to Egypt (4:24)?

From the context of verses 24-26, can you tell why God tried to take Moses' life? What had Moses done (or failed to do)?

3. At the end of chapter 4, Moses and Aaron went to the elders of Israel. Between Moses and Aaron, which one spoke to the people? Which one performed signs before the elders?

How did the people respond to Moses and Aaron (4:31)?

4. When Moses and Aaron went before Pharaoh, what was their first **request** (5:1)?

When Pharaoh refused their request, what changes or additions did they make to their request when they made it a second time (5:3)?

5. Pharaoh responded to their requestion by making Israel's workload even harder. How did he make their workload **harder**?
  
6. In the Egyptian slavery system, Egyptian taskmasters were at the top and the Israelite people were at the bottom, but what group was in the middle (vv. 10-14)?
  
7. When the workload for the people of Israel became too much to bear, who did the Israelite foremen go to first to voice their complaints (vv. 15ff)?

Who did they go to next to voice their complaints?

Who did Moses go to in order to voice his complaints?

8. The Lord responded to Moses' complaints in a speech in 6:2-8. In this section, how many times does God make the statement "**I am the LORD**"?

Because God had made a covenant with the people of Israel, he said, "I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians" (6:6). This is the first of many '**I will**' statements the Lord makes in verses 6-8. Write down each 'I will' statement that He makes.

9. In the genealogy of Moses and Aron, three sons of Jacob have descendants listed – Reuben, Simeon, and Levi. Which one gets almost all the attention?

Levi had three sons: Gershon, Kohath, and Merari. Which one gets special attention?

Between Moses and Aaron, which one gets more attention?
