2.	As chapter 18 opens, how many tribes had yet to receive their land allotment?
	Look at verses 5 and 7. What tribes had <i>already</i> received their land?
3.	Since seven tribes still needed to take possession of their land, Joshua told each tribe to select three men. What were those men to go out and do?
	When the men returned to Joshua, what would Joshua do?
4.	Where was Simeon's inheritance (19:1, 9)? Why was it there (19:9)?
	Instead of living in the land God gave them, where did the tribe of Dan end up dwelling?
5.	Before any of the tribes in Canaan received their inheritance, what man received his inheritance (14:6ff)? After all the tribes had received their land, what man received his inheritance?
6.	If you killed a person accidentally, you could flee to a city of refuge . How many such cities were there? What are some examples of accidental murder (Deut. 19:4-5; Num. 35:22-24)?

7.	What were some responsibilities that the elders of the city had toward the one who had accidentally killed someone (vv. 4, 5)?
8.	The one who killed someone accidentally couldn't leave a city of refuge until what two things had occurred (20:6)?
9.	In chapter 21, the Levites came to Joshua and the other leaders and asked for what?
	How many cities were allotted to the Levites?
10.	Look at Genesis 46:11 and Exodus 6:16. Who were the three sons of Levi?
	Which of Levi's three son was Aaron a descendant of (see Exodus 6:16-20)?
11.	Look carefully at 21:43-45. What are some themes that you see in these verses – some words or concepts that are <i>repeated throughout</i> these verses?
12.	In chapter 22, who were the tribes that Joshua sent back home? Where was their home?
13.	The 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ tribes built an altar . Where did they build it and what size was it?
	Why did the tribes of Israel think that they built it?
	Why did they actually build it?
